



Spectrum Glass presents: The System 96® Glass Craft Program

Project Guide

Giftwrap Platter ▪ dish

Glass Cutting: **simple, straight lines**

Firing: **semi-contour fuse, slump**



Step-by-Step

1. Begin with a White Square Blank.
2. Cut four 3¼-inch squares of Clear glass.
3. Cut two 1½ x 8 inch strips of Red (or “ribbon” color of your choice). Trim one of the strips into two 3¼ inch lengths.
4. Place the long Red strip in the center of the White blank. Create a cross by placing the two shorter Red strips on either side of the long one. Arrange the four Clear squares to fill in the remaining space around the cross shape.
5. Cut 4 triangles from the Red and arrange on top for the “bow.”
6. Add 3 Pebbles in each corner.
7. Semi-Contour fuse (or Contour Fuse).
8. Slump into a shallow square mold.

Materials We Used

Blanks: 8” White Square

Glass Colors: 100SFS Clear, 151SF Cherry Red Transparent

Pebbles: Assorted colors

Keys to Success

Semi-Contour Fuse: We fired at 1425 F for 10 minutes, to retain contour and dimension.

Variations:

For added interest, fire this project to a full fuse before adding the bow. Then add the bow pieces and fire to semi-contour. The Pebbles will be flat and melted in, but the bow will stand out dimensionally. Finally, slump!



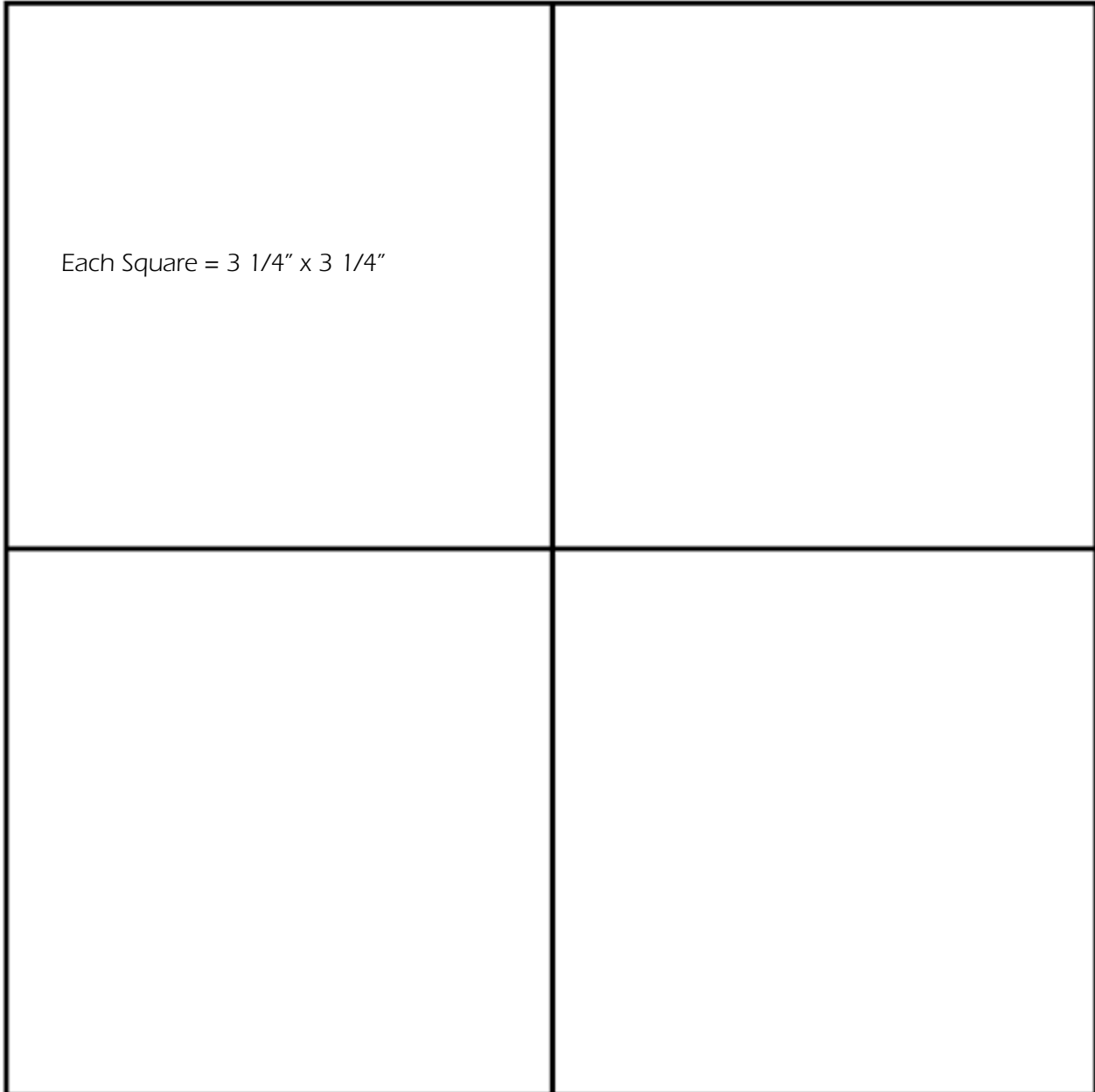
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Pattern Template -- Cut from Clear Glass
